PLEASE

- Ensure your child arrives at school before 7:30am. Too many late children on a daily basis.
- Ensure your child is not left standing on our pavement after school or after their extra mural activity for more than 15mins. It is not safe!
- Ensure your child attends school every day — too many absent children on a daily basis
- Ensure your child takes part in extra mural activities

- At our Taaibos gate — please park against the school pavement so that 2 lanes of traffic can move down the road towards the robot.
- Do not speak to a child, unless they are in the company of their parents.

All children who have excelled at a sport outside of school are invited to bring their kits and medals on Thursday 3 October, for photos.

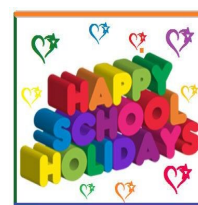


GRADE 2 INNINGS
