Our extra mural programme is up and running with matches and galas in full swing.

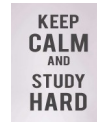
Our extra mural programme ends on Friday 8 November. Please ensure your child is collected directly after school from Monday 11 November to prevent your child standing on our school pavement.
